

EP13.05**Climate change and health, what's the role for the family doctor?**

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The WHO and the Lancet Commission have both identified climate change as the biggest medical challenge in the 21. century. At the same time the transition from fossil fuels represents the biggest health opportunity of our time as particulate pollution from burning fossil fuels account for an estimated 7 million deaths worldwide. The workshop will discuss the health implications associated with climate change and what strategies Family Doctors can apply to promote the transition towards clean energy. As a basis for the discussion there will be a short powerpoint presentation of material from WHO, The Lancet Commission and 'the Climate Reality Project' on the subject.
