Personal History: female, 30 years. Without interest. Present Illness: patient who comes to Emergencies guarded by Police, suspecting ingestion of drugs capsules. It has not been possible to make X-Ray because possibilitie of pregnancy.

Physical Examination: Good overall condition. No symptoms at the arrival to the Emergencies Service. Hemodynamically stable. Complementary tests: pregnancy test: negative. Abdominal x-ray: uncountables foreign objects.

Diagnosis: body-packer. Evolution: the patient stays for 48 hours in Observation Area in treatment with evacuation solution, where she expulses 101 drugs packs coinciding with patient confession. In x-ray abdominal there is no presence of foreign objects.

Conclusion: it is important to know how to work with patients under arrest. Pregnant women are a poblation with many restrictions.
